Canvassing Board Resolution No. 2022-01, Certifying the Statement of Canvass for the November 8, 2022 General Election

Background

Pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 205.185 and Fridley City Charter (Charter) § 4.09, the Fridley City Council (Council) shall meet and canvass any election returns between three and ten calendar days after any election. The Council must also make a full declaration of the results and file a statement with the City Clerk and Anoka County.

On November 8, 2022 (Election Day), the City, in concert with Anoka County and the State of Minnesota, conducted a General Election. On Election Day, eligible voters selected candidates for the City offices of Councilmember for Wards 1, 2, and 3. As of 7:00 a.m. on Election Day, the City had 16,971 registered voters. On Election Day 564 eligible voters registered to vote.

For this election, Absentee Balloting (AB) occurred between September 23, 2022 and November 7, 2022. Prior to Election Day, the City and Anoka County accepted 2,445 Absentee Ballots. Combined with the 10,321 ballots cast on Election Day, the City realized a voter turnout of approximately 58%.

The Statement of Canvass (Exhibit A) outlines the ballots cast and for whom for this election:

Vision Statement

We believe Fridley will be a safe, vibrant, friendly and stable home for families and businesses.

In addition to the Statement of Canvass, the Charter requires both the "names of the judges of the election" (Exhibit B) and "a true copy of the ballots used" (Exhibit C). In total, the City employed 120 election judges throughout its 10 polling locations on Election Day.

Certifying the Statement of Canvass for the General Election Held on November 8, 2022

Whereas, Minnesota Statute § 205.185 and Fridley City Charter (Charter) § 4.09 requires the Fridley City Council (Council), acting as the Canvassing Board, to certify results of the municipal election held on November 8, 2022; and

Whereas, Section 4.09 of the Charter requires such a Statement of Canvass to include the following:

- The total number of votes cast;
- The total number of individuals registered before 7:00 am on Election Day and the total number of individuals registering on Election Day;
- The total votes cast for each candidate, with a declaration of those who are elected;
- A true copy of the ballots used;
- The names of the judges of election;
- Such other information as may seem pertinent; and

Whereas, the Abstract of Votes Cast, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, contains all election results and statistics required by the Charter; and

Whereas, the Poll Worker Report, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, contains the names of Election Judges who were assigned to work at the City's 10 polling locations; and

Whereas, the Notice of Municipal Ballot, which is attached hereto as Exhibit C, is a true copy of the ballots used in the election; and

Whereas, as a result of the General Election held on November 8, 2022, the following individuals were elected to the following City offices:

Councilmember Ward 1: Tom Tillberry
Councilmember Ward 2: Ryan Evanson
Councilmember Ward 3: Ann Bolkcom; and

Whereas, Section 3.01 of the Charter directs those elected shall be sworn in at the regular meeting of the City Council on January 9, 2023 for terms expiring four years thereafter.

Now, therefore be it resolved, that the Canvassing Board for the City of Fridley hereby declares and certifies this Statement of Canvass, and its associated exhibits, for the General Election held on November 8, 2022.

Be it further resolved, that the City Clerk shall maintain on file this Statement of Canvass and transmit a certified duplicate of the same to the County Auditor.

Be it further resolved, that the City Clerk shall forthwith notify all persons elected of the fact of their election, and the persons elected shall take office at the time provided for by Section 3.01 of the Charter upon taking and filing with the City Clerk the required oath of office.

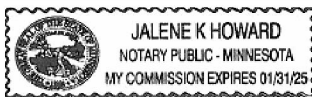
