Title

Anoka County Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Plan Update

Background

Anoka County developed a Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Plan focused on improving safety on county roads. This action plan will help guide roadway safety strategies throughout Anoka County to make streets and roads safer for everyone, including drivers, walkers, bikers, rollers, or by transit.

Throughout Minnesota, Anoka County, and around the country, traffic deaths have been rising after years of decline. The SS4A Plan is a tool to reverse this trend locally.

The SS4A Plan identifies a prioritized list of safety improvement projects based on data and stakeholder input. Anoka County will prioritize and secure funding for implementing safety projects.

Joe MacPherson, the Anoka County Engineer, will give an update on Anoka County's SS4A plan and be available for questions.
